Anne opened the meeting at about 7:00 PM.

Secretary's Report: Correction to the minutes: Esther stated that the money assigned to the Morgan Fund is not separate from the total of all funds. She will structure the 2010 report differently so that such an impression is not given.

Treasurer's Report:

Esther did not have a formal report for the meeting but reported that she has sent a check for \$300 to Unity Church for the marathon rent and \$168.35 to the Webmaster to reimburse her for the webhosting service that she had paid for us for 2009 plus \$90 for her own fees plus she has paid \$152.64 to Go Daddy to be our webhosting service for the next 3 years. Also, Michael continues to monitor our phone for the Intergroup, and Esther has given him \$31.80 for minutes on the phone. She has also sent a check to St. Mary's for \$144 for the 2010 rent for the Intergroup meetings.

Public Information Committee Report

No-one has volunteered for this position yet.

Literature: Anne reported that she has done an inventory in preparation for the marathon. After discussion of what is on hand, decisions were made as to what she will purchase as supplies for the marathon.

New Item: Alyssa reported that she has been contacted by St Joseph 's College in West Hartford and asked to do a presentation there on OA. It is scheduled for February 23rd, 7:30 PM. She will speak and then answer questions, and she would like to have some OA'ers present to help answer questions after the meeting. She passed this by OA World Service, which has given its OK. Sue will Email the flyer for the Marathon to her so that she can bring copies to that meeting, as well as some copies of the schedule, and it was agreed that Anne will give her some OA Literature, mostly flyers. Sue will also put a notice about this meeting in the newsletter that is about ready to be sent out.

Old Business:

A. Intergroup Workshop Marathon :

Sue V was unable to attend the meeting tonight, but remains in contact with Wendy. Wendy reported that:

1. West Hartford, Saturday morning meeting has agreed to host the Raffle for the Marathon .
2. Still no chair has come forward for the clothing exchange, which is in danger of being cancelled if no-one volunteers soon.
3. Gifts for the speakers and the door prize were discussed and agreed upon
4. Wendy and Sue V. have gone to Unity Church to evaluate it, and they have decided that it will not be necessary to do go there for set up the night before.
5. Anne does have a group of people committed to helping her man the literature table at the Marathon .

B. Website: Esther confirmed that we have changed our website service to GoDaddy to save money, and we are paid up for three years. Sue pointed out that the website is still mentioning the Morgan Fund and says that the funds are for supporting scholarships to the Intergroup's annual retreat, however we

haven't had a retreat in several years. Sue will ask Tina Lee to remove all references to the Morgan Fund.

C. Wendy reported that the discussion last time about the lost church key turned out to be a non-issue, as the church has told her that we were never given a copy! So we aren't facing an expense to replace it. The church has given Wendy a key now, which is signed out to her (Wendy), and she is the contact person for them.

Newsletter:

Sue reported that she has a newsletter about ready to go and will send it out the next couple of days.

Meetings Needing Help: Wendy advised that the Thursday Night meeting in East Hartford is in need of support.

Correspondance:

No-one picked up the correspondence this month. Wendy has not yet given the key to Mary nor has she trained her in what to do. She promised to do so before the next meeting.

New Business:

None reported.

DIRECTIONS TO THE CONNECTICUT INTERGROUP MEETINGS

(Third Monday of each month at 7:00 PM @ St Mary's Church, Manchester , CT , UNLESS otherwise specified)

From Route 91 connect to Route 84 using Route 291, then connect to Route 384

OR

From Route 84, connect to Route 384

On route 384, take Exit 3.

At end of ramp, go right onto Main Street

At the 6th traffic light after the ramp, go Left onto Park Street

At end of the block, see St Mary's Church on the corner of Park and Church Streets, on your right

Go Right onto Church Street

The church is still on your right, and you now see an annex attached to the back of the church. That is where the meeting is held.

You cannot park on the right side of the street, so park on the other side or on the next side street(Locust Street).

Enter the building using the ramp at the entrance closest to the main church building (just off the driveway)

Once inside, make an immediate left into the room!
